and THE UPEI FACULTY ASSOCIATION BARGAINING UNIT #2 (The Association)

In the event of a work interruption, lockout or legal strike, the following table identifies the positions, presently in existence and agreed to by the Parties, to provide Essential Services, as described in Article H-5, Strikes and Lockouts.

- 1. In the event that Article H6.4 and H6.5 come into effect, the applicable ongoing essential services schedules shall be forwarded by the Dean to the Vice-President, Academic and to the President, UPEIFA. Where schedules exist, only the persons scheduled, or their replacement if they are not available, shall provide the duties of the designated position.
- 2. Those clinicians on the essential services schedule for each of the service units shall provide:
 - a. all required care for teaching and research animals
 - b. all required care for animals admitted at the time of work stoppage until discharged
 - c. emergency care of animals under the primary care of the VTH

- d. primary, secondary, tertiary, and quaternary care where applicable, for emergent and urgent (having health-related time-sensitivity) veterinary patients will be provided at the discretion of the essential clinician on duty
- e. emergency and urgent diagnostic services.
- 3. When necessary, the essential clinician may request the assistance of another Faculty Member to provide care to a patient.
- 4. Essential services comprised of only one Faculty Member will provide primary and secondary care to animals at the Faculty Member's discretion.
- 5. Service units that are comprised of Faculty Members in both BU1 and BU2 will determine the appropriate number and schedule of Faculty Members needed to provide essential services.
- 6. Services units that are contractually obligated to provide services (e.g. small animal primary emergency service) will provide these services during the contractually required hours.
- 7. Those persons brought to provide essential services shall be remunerated in accordance with Article D-3, Emergency Services, of the Collective Agreement.
