GRADUATE STUDIES ADVISORY COMMITTEE¹

The mandate of the Graduate Studies Advisory Committee (GSAC) is to further the mission of UPEI in the pursuit of excellence in graduate studies, and to report to the UPEI yearly on Graduate Studies issues, trends, and initiatives. Activities of GSAC will complement and support those of the established faculty-level graduate committees and offices.

Terms of Reference:

- 1. Providing guidance and context to Senate on regional, national, and international issues concerning graduate studies
- 2. Developing, reviewing, and revising university-wide policies for graduate studies.
- 3. Reviewing and revising general graduate studies components of the academic calendar including academic regulations.
- 4. Supporting development of new graduate programming and ensuring the quality assurance review of existing graduate programming.
- 5. Coordinating UPEI Graduate Studies Research Days.
- 6. Setting the process for and adjudicating the Governor Generals Gold Medal for Graduate Studies
- 7. Establishing application procedures (and terms of reference) for both internal and external graduate scholarships and funding opportunities, and application adjudication as appropriate.
- 8. Developing strategies for graduate student recruitment and program growth.
- 9. Providing a liaison role between UPEI and the Canadian Association for Graduates Studies (CAGS) and other national and international associations.
- 10. Coordinating educational and professional development opportunities for graduate students and Postdoctoral Fellows.
- 11. Addressing and advising on issues related to Postdoctoral Fellows.
- 12. Creating and implementing policy on Graduate Faculty membership and supervisory role.
- 13. The committee will submit a summary report of activities to Senate annually.
